3 Keys to Boosting your Inner Confidence

ve been coaching for a few years now, and the biggest thing I've learnt - both for me and for my clients - is that inner confidence is the key to it all.

There are all kinds of strategies, ways of thinking, patterns of behaviour and practical tips for improving your life and feeling better about yourself, but they're all redundant if the foundation isn't there. That foundation is the real you, the you that you know deep down you are. The trick is that it takes confidence to find that and to bring out who you are – here are the three keys to real inner confidence.

Get to Know Your Values

Personal values are a big passion of mine and I often get carried away with myself when I talk about them. I make no apology for that though - they're one of the most important things you can know about yourself and are vital in getting genuine inner confidence. Your values are ten thousand feet down inside you, right at the very core of who you are, and they're the building blocks, the foundations and cornerstones for you. A value is something in yourself, in others or in the world that's most important to you, and could include things like respect, progress, family, fun, nature, achievement or freedom.

Why is it that some people and situations leave you feeling angry, frustrated, demotivated or deflated? It's because one or more of your values is being denied, suppressed or repressed – and we experience that as a negative experience because it's denying a fundamental piece of who you are. You know those times when you've felt really alive, amazing or buzzing? Those are the times when

one or more of your values are being honoured, and you can get more of that by living according to them.

Your values are all yours, and no matter what happens nobody can ever take them away. You can have absolute confidence in them because they're there all the time just waiting for you to notice them and use them. When you get to know your values you can start to make choices and align your life around them — it's so simple and it feels amazing because all that really means is that you're allowing who you are to live in the real world.

Trust Yourself

People spend too much time looking for signs that they're doing the right thing or on the right path. Sometimes we get that by hearing that we're doing well at work, sometimes it could be encouragement from a friend or loved one, and sometimes we get that feedback by seeing our material wealth or possessions growing.

But rather than looking on the outside for those signs, how about looking on the inside at what you're telling yourself? How about trusting yourself to do the best thing and make great choices? How about trusting your own insights and using your own intuition? I've seen those ideas scare the bejeezus out of people and you know why? Because it makes you accountable and responsible for what you get. If you trust yourself implicitly and you make the wrong choice you've got nobody else to blame.

But the fact is that we all make mistakes and we'll all continue to make mistakes. So how would it be if you could trust yourself to get through anything and trust yourself to continue making choices that serve you well – even if sometimes you screw up? That's the kind of trust I'm talking about, and that's genuine inner confidence

Start by listening to yourself and noticing what your intuition is telling you. Be aware of that little voice inside you or

those gut reactions you get and pay attention to what they're telling you. Trust yourself to make decisions, trust yourself to adapt and trust that you're good enough to have, do or be whatever you want True confidence will follow

Exercise the Muscle

Confidence is a muscle, and like any muscle you need to exercise it so that it doesn't shrink and waste away. The problem is that unlike your biceps or glutes, which tend to stay in the same place, your confidence muscle can be harder to find. How do you develop your biceps or firm up your glutes? By doing exercises that are designed to work that muscle over a period of time until you see the results you were looking for.

It's just the same with confidence. Let's say that you're the kind of person that doesn't take many risks. The kind of person who goes through each day doing what needs to be done and doing it well, but not really stretching yourself. You might talk yourself out of doing something because it's too scary or because you think to yourself 'I'm not good enough', 'that's not who I am' or 'I don't really want it anyway'. That kind of person lives within what they know and what keeps them safe and comfortable. The fewer risks they take, the less confident they need to be and so the less confident they become.

To work your confidence muscle you need to be prepared to take risks – big or small. You need to be willing to stretch yourself in an unfamiliar direction, to try something new or try something in a slightly different way. You need to open yourself up to the possibilities around you and push yourself to increase what you know, what you do and who you are. The more open you are to risk, opportunity and possibility the more confident you need to be, and so the more confidence you'll develop. That's your confidence muscle – the question is, what are you going to do to exercise it?

Seven foods

WINE

the last number of years. Having some alcohol if in moderation appears to help aging adults put off diabetic issues, heart problems along with memory loss.

CHOCOLATE

Cocoa, which chocolate is derived from, is really laden with flavanols that help sustain capillaries for functioning appropriately. Strong veins and arterial blood vessels preserve a strong flow of blood to all of our cells, which in turn could reduce the chance of dementia, kidney problems and type-2 diabetes, as well as keep blood pressure levels controllable. Just as with virtually everything, moderation as well as knowing the other ingredients that go into nutritious chocolate must be monitored.

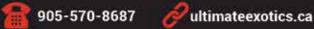

orsche is celebrating the 60th anniversary of the 911 with a special edition built for maximum driving enjoyment: in a limited run of 1,963 examples worldwide, the Porsche 911 S/T offers lightweight design and a purist driving experience. For the first time, the 518 HP high-revving engine from the 911 GT3 RS delivers its power to the road via a manual gearbox and lightweight clutch.

To mark the special anniversary of the iconic 911 sports car, the engineers in Weissach have designed a highly purist sports car dedicated to sheer driving enjoyment: the 911 S/T.

The exclusive anniversary model unites the strengths of the 911 GT3 with Touring Package and the 911 GT3 RS and delivers a unique combination of agility and driving dynamics. It combines the naturally aspirated, 518 HP 4.0-litre boxer engine from the 911 GT3 RS with a short-ratio six-speed manual transmission. This is complemented by a resolutely lightweight construction and a running-gear setup optimized for agility and drivability. The 911 S/T weighs just 1,380 kilograms (DIN kerb weight, incl. all fluids), making it the lightest model of the 992 generation. The optional Heritage Design Package draws inspiration from the racing version of the 911 S from the late 1960s and early 1970s.

The design of the anniversary model



incorporated GT and motorsport expertise from Porsche. This is reflected in its particularly nimble and agile handling, which is designed for maximum driving enjoyment on winding country roads.

The reduction of rotating mass in both the engine as well as the wheels and brakes ensures particularly dynamic responsiveness. The S/T responds to driver commands instantaneously. Every steering movement, every ounce of pressure on the accelerator or brake is implemented immediately and with pinpoint precision. Unlike the 911 GT3 RS, the focus of the development of the 911 S/T has been not on track use, but rather for journeys on public roads.

The name marks out the new 911 S/T as the descendant of a particularly performance-focused version of the first 911 generation. From 1969, Porsche

offered a special race version of the 911 S. Internally, these vehicles were called 911 ST.

Modifications to the chassis, wheels, engine and body significantly improved acceleration, braking, traction, and cornering grip. Large spoilers and other

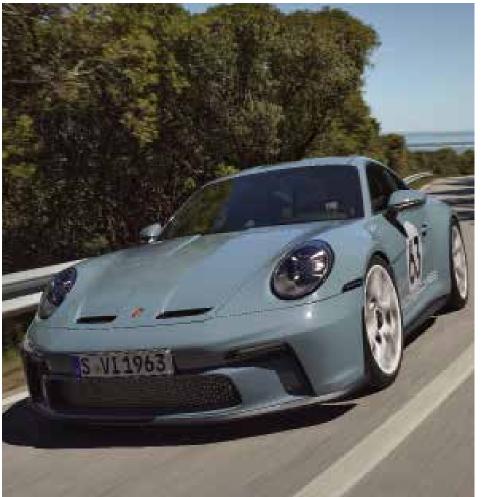
aerodynamic aids were not yet used in these models. The new 911 S/T takes up the spirit of the original 911 S (ST) and transfers it to the current model generation of the Porsche 911.

The anniversary model combines elements of the 911 GT3 RS with the body of the 911 GT3 with Touring Package and supplements it with lightweight components specially developed for the 911 S/T. The result is a unique driving experience within the 911 GT portfolio.

Lightweight construction from the wings to the clutch

Among other measures, the 911 S/T achieves its particularly agile and direct handling through consistent lightweight design. The front hood, roof, front wings, and the doors with their striking inlets are made of lightweight carbon-





fibre-reinforced plastic (CFRP). The same applies to the rear axle anti-roll bar and shear panel (stiffening element on the rear axle). Porsche also fits the anniversary model with magnesium wheels, the PCCB system, a lithium-ion starter battery and lightweight glass, all as standard.

With reduced insulation, the omission of rear-axle steering and weight savings in the powertrain, the 911 S/T achieves a DIN kerb weight of just 1,380 kg. This makes the car, optimized for a fast-road setup, a further 40 kg lighter than a manual 911 GT3 Touring.

Porsche engineers developed a new lightweight clutch exclusively for the 911 S/T. In conjunction with a single-mass flywheel, it reduces the weight of the rotating mass by 10.5 kg. This noticeably improves the responsiveness of the naturally aspirated boxer engine, which now builds revs with especially bracing speed and directness. Coupled with a six-speed manual transmission with a shorter gear ratio than on the 911 GT3, the high-revving engine in the 911



S/T delivers even more immediacy in its dynamics. It propels the 911 S/T to 100 km/h in just 3.7 seconds. It achieves a top speed of 300 km/h.

The exhilarating driving experience is heightened by the compelling soundscape of the standard lightweight sports exhaust system. The 911 S/T is the only 911 of the current generation to combine a double-wishbone front-axle design with a multi-link rear axle without rear-axle steering. The dampers and control systems were tuned accordingly.

The aerodynamics of the 911 S/T are also optimized for the public road rather than the racing track. The anniversary model is equipped as standard with a Gurney flap on the extending rear spoiler. Standard equipment also includes 20inch (front) and 21-inch (rear) lightweight centre-locking magnesium wheels. Ultrahigh-performance 255/35 ZR 20 tires, meanwhile, ensure a high level of mechanical grip at the front of the car.

On the rear, the 911 S/T features 315/30 ZR 21 tires. CFRP full bucket seats come as standard. The four-wayadjustable Sports Seat Plus is available at no extra charge. The instrument cluster and the clock of the Sport Chrono package are finished in a classic green Porsche colour scheme.

The 911 S/T is offered with an optional exclusive Heritage Design Package. The new Shoreblue Metallic exterior colour and the Ceramica wheel rim colour are exclusively available for this particularly elegant variant.

On the doors, a starting number from 0 to 99 as well as a decorative foil can be applied on request. The classic-design Porsche crest from the original 911 that adorns the front, the hubcaps, the steering wheel, the headrests, and the car key underscores the historic roots of the 911 S/T. The interior also features cloth seat centres in Classic Cognac with black pinstripes, which are another

homage to heritage. Two-tone semianiline leather trim in Black/Classic Cognac leather with extensive leather surrounds, a roof lining in perforated Dinamica, and other elements from Porsche Exclusive Manufaktur round out the package. 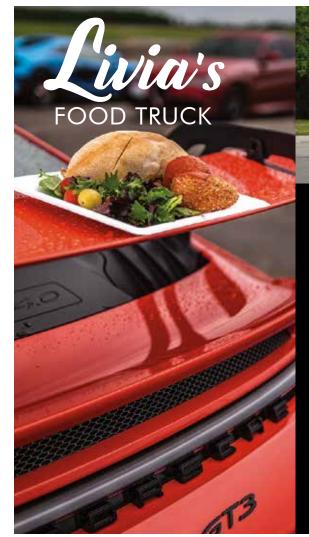

Winter is almost here. Why we should consider exercising outside

Researchers have found in studies that our production of a chemical that promotes fat storage almost doubles during the winter. In another test it was found that reduced sunlight also reduces our serotonin activity. When this happens people will crave sweets and carbohydrates because the brain is making up for the lack of serotonin. These cravings only make it harder to keep the weight off.

Exercise of course helps release serotonin and will put a stop to those carbohydrate cravings. Blame it on lack of sunlight, but it's something we must fight through during the winter. Understanding these biological tendencies might help to understand what we're up against.

Other than getting the benefit of more sunlight, there are some reasons very good reasons why winter workouts when done outdoors can be extremely beneficial:

Workouts tend to last longer

Studies have shown that older adults exercise longer outdoors than indoors.

Perhaps that's because those that are willing to brave the winter weather are more motivated, but being outside does improve a person's mood, increases energy levels, and relieves boredom.

Nature has healing powers

the current owner – Jean-André Charial. Throughout years, it became the beloved spot by renowned writers, talented painters, crowned heads (including Queen Elizabeth), celebrities, gourmets, and tourists. Raymond Thuilier's cuisine acquired fame and became awarded with three Michelin stars in 1954

The story of this unique place unfolds in a truly fascinating way. In 1969 Jean-André Charial joined his grandfather Raymond Thuilier and they worked together for 24 years by making the most of their generation gap. Since the death of his grandfather in 1993, Baumanière has been bequeathed to Jean-André Charial and his wife Geneviève.

The property now boasts 53 rooms and suites, two restaurants: a 3 Michelin star restaurant L'Oustau de Baumanière and La Cabro d'Or, a spa, 3 swimming pools, a chocolate factory, and a pottery workshop run by the ceramist Cécile Cayrol. It passes on to its customers the richness of the land offering a unique and authentic experience of Provence. To top it all off, numerous collaborations with local artisans are visible throughout the property.

The main design idea for the suites was a timeless and organic style, staying true to the history of the place and Provence itself. Some rooms have been renovated by Geneviève Charial, accompanied by

Before or after a gourmet feast, guests can visit the spa to unwind while connecting to nature. Its space is designed in a way that it opens straight into the gardens.
